Thanks to the click design, the installation of the panels is simple and intuitive, and the joints are very subtle and do not require grouting.







Calacatta Snow









Calacatta White













Rusty






Concrete Dust








Concrete Light






Ash Grey

Hygienic:


- SPC wall panels do not require grouting, which helps avoid areas that can potentially be exposed to mould and fungi.

Subtle:

- SPC wall panels are 0,4 cm thick - taking up less space than tiles.
